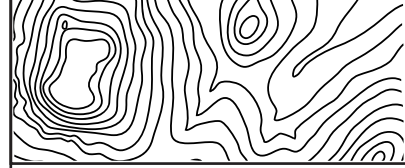
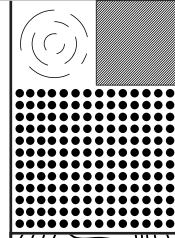


MINOR IN ARCHITECTURAL HISTORY & THEORY
