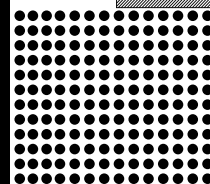

30 units of Graduate level course work are required to complete graduate degree. (This may include up to 12 units of AMP credit).

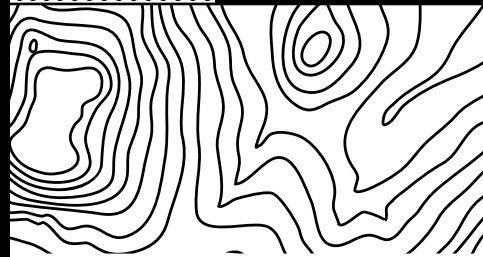
