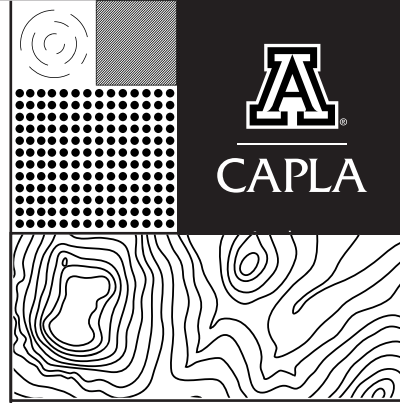


MINOR IN ARCHITECTURAL HISTORY & THEORY CURRICULUM

NOTES

The Minor in Architectural History and Theory consists of six courses (18 units).

Three courses in the minor core are required, for a total of 9 units.

For electives, 6 units must be from: ARC 471X / ARC 471-SA OR an ARH 480 / ARH 480-SA course that contains a substantial architectural component with prior written approval of the History and Theory stream chair.

For electives, 3 additional units must come from: one of the courses listed here OR from ARC 471X / ARC 471-SA OR an approved ARH 480 / ARH 480-SA course that contains a substantial architectural component with prior written approval of the History and Theory stream chair OR from another upper-level course meeting the same criteria.
